Read merit badge requirements on www.usscouts.org. We suggest you print out & bring the worksheets for the badges.

Please **BE PREPARED**:

For **ALL** merit badge sessions,

1. **Read the merit badge booklet IN ADVANCE, do as much as you can beforehand.**
2. Bring items to take notes (paper, pen, clipboard/something else to write on)
3. Bring a blue card for EACH session, filled out with your information, signed by your Scoutmaster
4. Scout uniform is strongly encouraged
5. Arrive at least 20 minutes before your first session & be prepared to **actively participate!**

Special notes: (Note: If there are multiple sessions of the same merit badge, only register for ONE session)

Adult Leaders – Training Discussion

Adult CPR -\$20/adult if NOT affiliated with a troop. All others, \$10 (adult and youth)

Camping - Can bring log to verify Req. 9 and any other evidence of completing requirements

Citizenship/Nation - Read MBBook & all docs. listed in 4. Make/bring notes for all discussions. Do #s 5, 7 & 8 & bring with you

Citizenship/Society - Read the 'pamphlet/requirements' thoroughly. Do reqs 1 AND 8 beforehand and be prepared to discuss ALL requirement

Cooking – special notes will be emailed to registrants; **Bring \$15** to cover food costs, etc.

Disabilities Awareness- no special notes

Dog Care – special notes will be emailed to registrants

Emergency Preparedness- do as much as you can on the worksheet that will be provided to registrants

Engineering – special notes will be emailed to registrants when received (if any)

Fingerprinting - no special notes

First Aid - Req 1 must be completed prior to registering for badge & bring proof thereof, prepare and BRING the home first aid kit (Req. 5a)

Fly Fishing – Learn and practice a loop knot (either double surgeon or perfection loop) & improved cinch knot. Look at fishing regulations

(<https://www.eregulations.com/washington/fishing/>) & be ready to discuss.

Graphic Arts – Do Req 7 and bring with you. Start designing your printed piece (req 3) with text & art. (bookmark, flier, program, sticker, etc)

Hiking/Backpacking -special notes will be emailed to registrants for this session.

Indian Lore - Complete reqs 2 & 5 beforehand and bring written reports

Law - Do Reqs. 4 beforehand and bring with you

Moviemaking -no special notes

Music – no special notes

Nature – special notes will be emailed to registrants when received (if any)

Personal Management - Prepare to be able to pass off the requirements of the badge, with a focus on requirements 1a, 2a, 2b, 3, 4, 9, 10

Photography – Registrants to email MB Counselor Bryan Blair at bryanwardblair@gmail.com for special instructions (be sure to copy another adult)

Public Speaking -1. Be prepared to give a 3-5 minute introduction of yourself. 2. Prepare a 3-5 minute talk on a topic of your choice and bring visual aids to use in presenting it. If you have already completed requirement 2, bring a note signed by your troop leader or parent/guardian. 4. If you have completed requirement 4, bring a note signed by your troop leader or parent/guardian

Reading - special notes will be provided upon registering for this badge

Snow Sports – read requirements. Bring video of Scout demonstrating the skills, if available

Sustainability – special notes will be emailed to registrants when received (if any)
